

Community Development Assistance Service Fees *

◆ Nonprofit & Program Development

Services are fine tuned to your needs and are provided at your place of business or in small meetings, so as to facilitate a one-to-one approach. Fees may vary. Current minimum Fee rate: \$25/hr

◆ Funds Development, Grants, Donors

Services are based on your organizations needs so a Plan of Action toward funds development and a Readiness Study are first and foremost on the agenda. Fees may vary. Current Minimum Fee: \$25/hr. Associated Grant Writers fee varies: Current fees \$50/hr. Grant Funding Research fee \$50. Grant Plan of Action \$100.

◆ Project Management

Each project is unique in its needs and services. We will typically charge by the hour depending on the complexity of the services needed. Fees will be negotiated with each individual project but current minimum is a \$25/hour fee.

◆ Board & Management Training

Training on all aspects of nonprofit management and multiple aspects of Board governance are available. Sessions are provided in small groups at your place of business in a workshop format. Costs may vary depending on need. Minimum current costs are \$100 per person attending, for each 4 hour session.

All services are provided with the utmost care for your mission needs. Our nonprofit professionals consult with you on a one-on-one basis so that your direct needs can be determined and so that your mission will be served efficiently and effectively. Alamo RCD is here to serve you so that our communities can thrive!
