From Grant Seeking to Grant Winning

Boerne, Texas – The Alamo Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) Area, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is sponsoring a two day “From Grant Seeking to Grant Winning” Proposal Writing Workshop, June 28-29, 2007 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at St. Francis Hall, 117 W. Hosack in Boerne, Texas. The cost of the two-day workshop is \$100 for RC&D members and \$130 for nonmembers. All materials and refreshments will be provided. Accessing these funds requires skill in proposal research, evaluation and writing. Proposal writing is a recognized profession and a necessity for the survival of many non-profit organizations.
